#### Reports

**Superintendent Report** – Mark Tucker had supplied a report.

#### **New Business**

**FY22 Audit Results** – Michael Concessi was present. FY22 ended as expected. Mike shared the audit with the board to look through. Ended with an audited surplus of 1.1 million. We knew we had this surplus, and it was used for items in FY23 and FY24. Capital funds ended with 95k.

**Preliminary Financial Updates for FY23** – FY23 looks to be ending with a surplus of a little over a million. FY24 is using \$225k to bring down tax obligation and \$75k for Capital funds.

Board discussed the individual school reserves and Mike went over those accounts as well.
